Narrator Jesus Speakers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

Priest The Lord be with you.

All And with your spirit.

Priest A reading from the holy gospel + according to Mark.

All Glory be to you, O Lord.

Narrator Jesus showed himself to the Eleven while they were at table

and he said to them:

Jesus Go out to the whole world;

proclaim the Good News to all creation.

He who believes and is baptised will be saved; he who does not believe will be condemned.

These are the signs that will be associated with believers:
